- Obstructions to pedestrians or sight obstructions for vehicles
- Any electrical/ plumbing work servicing the outdoor seating area

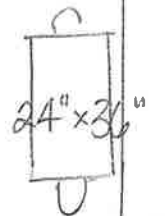
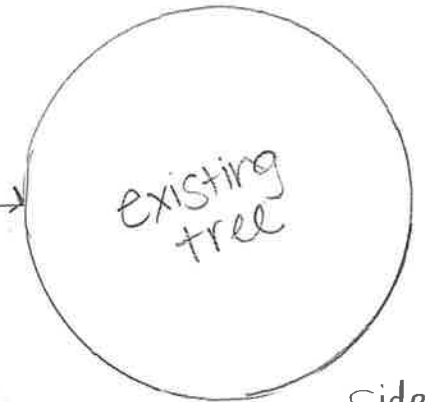
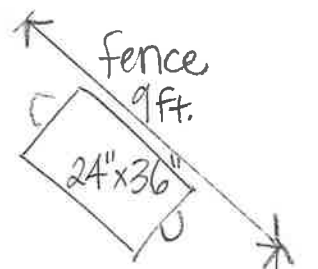
