**32nd ANNUAL LETTER CARRIERS' "STAMP OUT HUNGER" FOOD DRIVE DAY
MAY 11, 2024**

WHEREAS, every second Saturday in May, the National Association of Letter Carriers and the National Rural Letter Carriers Association mobilize to combat hunger during the "Stamp Out Hunger" Food Drive; over 1.9 billion pounds of food has been collected nationally; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, Naperville letter carriers collected nearly 60,000 lbs. pounds of donated food for distribution by Loaves & Fishes Community Services; and
