

ORDINANCE NO. 21-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 3 (DEFINITION) AND
SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS) OF
TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL),
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 3 (Definitions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-3: - DEFINITIONS: For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR through
SHOPPING CENTER * * *

<u>SMALL BATCH WHISKEY</u>	<u>Bourbon or rye whiskey from a craft distillery that is a smaller bottling of not more than 7,000 cases per year which results in unique flavors and characteristics among the barrels. Small batch productions represent a craft distillery's more exclusive bourbon or rye whiskeys, which are at a higher price point</u>
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SMOKING ALCOHOL INHALATION through
WINE OR VINOUS BEVERAGE * * *

SECTION 2: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

- 1. On-premises consumption liquor licenses: * * *
- 2. Off-Premises Consumption Liquor Licenses: * * *
- Class D – Package Store** through
Class S – Specialty Wine Shop * * *

	<u>Class S1 – Specialty Food and Liquor Shop</u>
Requirements of Premises	Contains all of the requirements of the Class S license and <u>Premises shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.</u> Not less than 40% of the premises shall be designated for the sale of specialty foods.
Consumption	Off-premises, except consumption on premises <u>of not more than 3 oz. of craft distilled whiskey or small batch whiskey, or 18 oz. of wine, or 32 oz. of craft beer per person/day for liquor tastings.</u>
Container Requirements	199 ml containers must be confined to a closed display unit. All liquor products, other than wine, (bottles) must bear the establishment's private label. <u>Retail sale of craft beer, wine, craft distilled whiskey or small batched whiskey in its original package.</u>
Liquor Tasting	3 tastings per person/day; no more than ¼ oz. of spirits, 1 oz. of wine, or 2 oz. of beer per tasting. Tastings are limited to one type of alcoholic liquor per person/day. Tasting hours: 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Tasting cups remain with BASSET trained employees.
Annual Fee	\$3,600.00
Other	Capped at 1. The Class S1 license is exempted from the restrictions in Section 3-3-12:7 (Downtown Establishments).
