Subject: Proposed New Sidewalk Construction – Property Owner Input

«NAME»:

The City has identified your block as a candidate for new sidewalk installation through the annual New Sidewalk Program. Candidates were selected based on numerous factors including proximity to schools, connectivity to the existing pedestrian network, and roadway classification. This program is funded by the City, and there is no cost to the property owner. The sidewalk is typically located 1 ft off the property line. This location may shift to avoid conflicts in the parkway.

To incorporate resident feedback in the selection process, all property owners adjacent to a gap sidewalk segment (whether their property already has sidewalk or not) are requested to provide their input on the proposed sidewalk by submitting the attached survey. This survey's results will supersede results from any previous surveys that may have been performed for your block, so **new responses must be submitted in order to be considered in the current selection cycle.**

Gap segments that are opposed by more than two thirds of adjacent property owners will be removed from consideration for near-term sidewalk installation. The remaining gap segments will be ranked by percentage of property owner support and will be presented to the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) later this summer for approval of selected locations. If your block received positive support, you will receive another letter in advance of the TAB meeting inviting you to attend and provide additional public input.

Note that final location selection is dependent on TAB and City Council approval; blocks with positive support are not guaranteed to be included in the upcoming construction seasons. Final approved locations will be installed in the summer/fall of either 2026, 2027, or 2028. Locations with the most property owner support will receive priority, so property owners are encouraged to speak with their neighbors in order to maximize the survey response rate. In the event of a tie between locations, non-responses shall be counted as support.
