### **Field Report for June, 2026:**

- Staff continue with routine maintenance tasks including weeding, pruning, and hedge-trimming (hedge trimmed photo included)
- The plaque for the Mr. and Mrs. Naperville statue has been installed (photo included)
- A contractor pressure-washed the granite stones around the Exchange Club Memories Fountain at Fredenhagen Park and painted the letters in each granite stone (photo included)
- We experienced significant storm damage in the afternoon of June 10. Almost all of the damage was tree-related and we did not have damage to Riverwalk assets. With the help of additional Park District staff from other divisions and two tree contractors, we were able to get the majority of the broken branches and debris cleaned up in 2 days. We only lost 4 Riverwalk landscape trees (1 near Rotary Hill and 3 near the Jaycees playground) which will be replaced this fall.
- A donor through the Conservation Foundation once again donated over 650 native plugs to plant along the river. We are grateful for these beautiful and sustainable additions to the Riverwalk!

### **Carillon Update – (NPD)**

- Carillon tours and recitals are scheduled through the summer.

### **Other points of interest:**

- The Duck Race on June 5 was a success and was well-attended
- The storm on June 10 also significantly impacted Centennial Beach which had to close for the day on June 11 for clean-up. The Beach opened with regular hours on Friday, June 12.
