ROSEMARY MACKO WISNOSKY RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, Rosemary Macko Wisnosky has dedicated more than 46 years of service to local, national, and international communities as a civic leader, businesswoman, and volunteer; and

WHEREAS, after moving to Naperville, Rosemary quickly became involved in the community, joining the Naperville Area Chamber of Commerce in 1983 and serving as its president in 1988; and

WHEREAS, her civic engagement continued through membership in the Rotary Club of Naperville and as a founding board member of the Slovak American Cultural Society of the Midwest; and

WHEREAS, as a founding member of the Naperville Sister Cities Commission in 1993, Rosemary helped establish the partnership between Naperville and Nitra, Slovakia, later earning recognition as an Honorary Citizen of Nitra in 2000 and a Medal of Honor from the Embassy of the Slovak Republic in Washington, D.C. in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Rosemary has served as a trustee of Benedictine University since 1994, supported international diplomacy efforts in 2002 related to NATO expansion, and contributed to environmental stewardship through her work with The Conservation Foundation; and

WHEREAS, from 2012 until January 29, 2026, Rosemary served as Honorary Consul of the Slovak Republic, strengthening economic, cultural, and diplomatic ties while assisting Slovak citizens and promoting international understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Wehrli, Mayor of the City of Naperville, do hereby recognize **ROSEMARY MACKO WISNOSKY** for her lifelong dedication to service in the City of Naperville.
