Lower Walkway Bench Measurements, for discussion at April PD&C

General Measurements:

- The narrowest widths (from the wall to the edge of the concrete walkway) along the lower walk of section 5 are approximately 5 feet.
- Our standard bench seat height is 16"
- From the Amphitheater to the covered bridge, the retaining wall height is 27"
- The wall height varies east of the covered bridge (See Area 3 Picture and Notes)



<u>Area 1:</u> This is the first spot to the east of the amphitheater (labeled 1 on Map). From the wall to the edge of the lower walkway is approximately 12 feet of space. In the following picture, there is 7 feet of space between our model's feet and the edge of the walkway.

Also in this picture (The circled arrow on the Map), I measured the width from the wall to the edge of the lower walkway immediately east of the amphitheater and it is 5 feet wide.



<u>Area 2:</u> The next spot further east (labeled 2 on the Map). From the wall to the edge of the lower walkway is approximately 10.5 feet. In the following picture, there is approximately 5 feet of space from our model's feet to the edge of the walkway.



<u>Area 3:</u> Looking west of the ramp near the Horse Trough Fountain (labeled 3 on the map). The wall height varies in this area. The wall height starts at 21" near the ramp, goes up to 27" where the first curve is, then back down to 21". Placing a bench in either of these 2 areas would result in less than 5 feet of clearance if someone was sitting in the bench with their feet extended.
