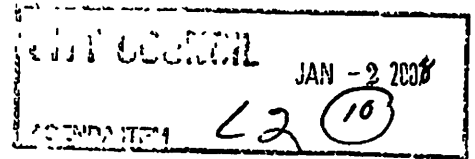

**SUBJECT:** Islamic Center Parking Study (2844 W Ogden Avenue)

On Friday, November 2, 2007, City of Naperville employees Shelley Scarbrough, Doug Splitt, and Sean Marquez performed a parking count study for the Islamic Center of Naperville at 2844 W Ogden Avenue, Naperville, IL. The parking study began at 1:00 pm and ended at 2:15. Currently the Islamic Center parking lot has 90 parking spaces. Once the proposed improvements are completed it will have 177 parking spaces.

The parking count was conducted by Sean Marquez crossing Ogden Avenue and counting the vehicle parking in the Outback, Micheals, and Century Tile parking lots. Shelley Scarbrough was counting the Vehicles parking in the FCA, and Pep Boys parking lots with the help of Doug Splitt. Once the lot was filled Doug Splitt counted the number of vehicles in the Islamic Center Parking lot.

Once the Islamic Center parking lot was full vehicles were double parked, parked on grass, and parked in the playground area near and around the playground equipment. Every possible space a car could be parked was filled.

The final results of the parking study were as follows:
