

ORDINANCE NO. 22 - _____

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 19
(SPECIAL EVENTS AND CULTURAL AMENITIES COMMISSION)
OF TITLE 2 (BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS) OF
THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Chapter 19 (Special Events and Cultural Amenities Commission) of Title 2 (Boards and Commissions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and by adding the underlined language as follows:

TITLE 2 – BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

CHAPTER 19 – SPECIAL EVENTS AND CULTURAL AMENITIES COMMUNITY ARTS COMMISSION

SECTION:

2-19-1: - CREATION AND PURPOSE:

There is hereby established a Special Events and Cultural Amenities Community Arts (SECA) Commission to assist, inform and advise the City Council on matters pertaining to the arts, culture, and special events in the City of Naperville. This Commission is established to assist the City in furthering special events and cultural amenities (SECA) experiences and in addition to supporting community arts through the administration of the Public Arts Program and providing recommendations to the City Council for the annual allocation of the SECA Grant Fund Program.

The SECA Grant Fund Program is funded by a portion of the revenue collected from the Citywide food and beverage tax and used solely to fund the Public Arts Program and create opportunities to provide social events and artistic experiences for Naperville and its visitors.

2-19-2: - MEMBERSHIP:

Initially, as of the effective date of this ordinance, the Commission shall consist of nine (9) eleven (11) members. Thereafter, as member terms expire, they shall not be replaced until the Commission stands at nine (9) members and thereafter the Commission shall consist of nine (9) members. Preferably, members shall have professional expertise in the various facets of the duties of the Commission, by virtue of their training and/or employment. Said areas of expertise may include, but are not necessarily limited to, business, nonprofit management, arts, social or artistic events, diversity, and culture.

2-19-3: - TERMS:

Term limits shall conform to the provisions of Section 2-1-6, "Terms And Term Limits", of this Title.

2-19-4: - DISCLOSURE:

1. Any member with an ownership, employment, or family interest, financial or nonfinancial, pursuant to Section 1-13-6 of this Code, in any SECA application, shall file with the Commission a signed and dated disclosure, stating their name, the name of the SECA applicant, and identifying their interest in the SECA application, prior to the Commission or City Council consideration of the SECA application.
2. Any member with an interest in a SECA application shall recuse themselves from any discussion or vote on the matter.
3. The disclosure form shall be submitted to the SECA Commission staff liaison and kept on file for the duration of the member's term.
4. Failure of a member to file a disclosure form pursuant to this Section may subject the member to immediate removal from the Commission.

2-19-5: - POWERS AND DUTIES:

1. Receive and review annual SECA Grant Fund applications.
2. Provide a recommendation to the City Council regarding the annual allocation of the SECA funds Grant Fund portion of the food and beverage tax.
3. Reserved.
4. ~~Encourage~~ Assist the City of Naperville in furthering the arts, culture cultural experiences, and special events in Naperville.
5. Provide recommendations to the City Council regarding the SECA policy, procedures, and application in accordance with the SECA mission statement.

6. Administer the City of Naperville Public Arts Program.

2-19-6: - GENERAL PROVISIONS:

All other actions, duties, procedures, and powers of the SECA Commission shall adhere to the provisions listed in Chapter 1 of Title 2 (Boards and Commissions).

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval.
