

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR THE CITY OF
NAPERVILLE, ILLINOIS**

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the City of Naperville, Illinois for 2020 will be held December 15, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, and pursuant to section 120/7(e) of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, the continuation of the Illinois Governor's disaster proclamation, and Naperville Mayor Chirico's executive order determining that in-person public meetings are not currently practical or prudent because of the COVID-19 pandemic, this public hearing will be held via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. All those interested are invited to attend the virtual public hearing via Zoom or over a telephone to contemporaneously hear all discussion, testimony and votes. Public comments may be submitted in writing in advance of the meeting and members of the public in attendance may sign-up in advance to provide live, oral comments.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2019 were \$42,130,516.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2020 are \$44,074,906. This represents a 4.62% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2019 were \$9,560,214.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2019 are \$18,052,070. This represents a 88.82% increase over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2019 were \$51,690,730.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2020 are \$62,126,976. This represents a 20.19% increase over the previous year.
