WHAT IS AN E-BIKE?

A bicycle with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than 750 watts.

16+

NOTE: Devices exceeding 750 watts, that do not have operable pedals, or that go faster than 28 mph without pedaling are NOT e-bikes and are prohibited in Naperville unless titled and registered as motor vehicles.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Functioning brakes
- Front-facing white light
- Rear-facing red reflector or light
- Reflective tires or wheel rims
- Functional speedometer (Class 3 e-bikes only)
- Visible class label
- Helmet strongly encouraged

WHAT IS AN E-SCOOTER?

A device weighing less than 100 pounds, with 2 or 3 wheels, handlebars, and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding, that is powered by a motor, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the devices reaches 10 mph.



NOTE: Scooters with motors capable of sustained speeds exceeding 10 mph without human assistance are prohibited in Naperville unless titled and registered as motor vehicles.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Front-facing white light
- Rear-facing red reflector or light
- Functioning brakes
- Helmet strongly encouraged

WHAT ISN'T AN E-BIKE?

Any two- or three-wheeled device with a motor exceeding 750 watts, that does not have operable pedals, or that goes faster than 28 mph without pedaling. This includes motor-driven cycles, minibikes, or pocket bikes. These devices are NOT e-bikes and are prohibited in Naperville unless titled and registered as motor vehicles.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Functioning brakes
- Front-facing white light
- Rear-facing red reflector or light
- Reflective tires or wheel rims
- Functional speedometer (Class 3 only)
- Visible class label
- Helmet strongly encouraged

WHAT IS AN E-SCOOTER?

A device weighing less than 100 pounds, with 2 or 3 wheels, handlebars, and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding, that is powered by a motor, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the devices reaches 10 mph.

Scooters with motors capable of sustained speeds exceeding 10 mph without human assistance are prohibited in Naperville unless titled and registered as motor vehicles.
