

ORDINANCE NO. 22 - ____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 (TRUCK ROUTES) OF
TITLE 11 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC)
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule authority as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 3 (Truck Routes) of Title 11 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language as follows:

11-3-1: WEIGHT; TRUCK ROUTES:

1. * *
2. Vehicles in Excess of Eight Thousand Pounds Restricted to Designated Truck Routes: It is unlawful to operate any vehicle in excess of eight thousand (8,000) pounds, or any vehicle with a registered weight greater than eight thousand (8,000) pounds pursuant to the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/3-815, on any street not designated and posted as a truck route, subject to the following exceptions:
 - 2.1. * *
 - 2.2. No vehicle shall be operated in excess of the following weight restrictions in the following area designated as special weight restriction zones:
 - 2.2.1 * * *
 - 2.2.1.1 * *
 - ~~2.2.2 5th Avenue Bridge over Cress Creek (between Ogden Avenue and Royal St. George Drive).~~
 - ~~2.2.2.1 Vehicles shall not exceed fifty thousand (50,000) pounds (twenty five (25) tons) in the aggregate.~~

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision, shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other City ordinance, resolution, or provision of the Naperville Municipal Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
