## Declaration of a Local State of Emergency and Disaster

City of Naperville

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of the Mayor by 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 20 ILCS 3305/11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, Sections 10-1-1 and 1-8D of the Naperville Municipal Code, and the Ordinance Pertaining to a Local State of Emergency and Disaster approved by the Naperville City Council on this date ("Ordinance"), I, Steve Chirico, the Mayor of the City of Naperville, do hereby declare that a local state of emergency and disaster (hereinafter "Local State of Emergency") exists as of this date, March 17, 2020 for the reasons set forth below and shall continue until such time as provided in said Ordinance.

The nature of the emergency is COVID-19, a contagious virus for which there is currently no vaccine and which, if contracted can cause severe respiratory illness and is sometimes fatal. On January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of COVID-19 to be a public health emergency of international concern, and on March 11, 2020 declared it to be a worldwide pandemic. On March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued a disaster proclamation pertaining to COVID-19, and activated the State Emergency Operations Center. On March 15, 2020, the Governor also announced that all bars and dine-in restaurants would close through March 30, 2020 due to COVID-19 concerns (as formally executed by COVID-19 Executive Order No. 5 issued on March 16, 2020). Public and private entities around the world are taking steps, including but not limited to, full or partial closings to reduce public exposure to COVID-19. Individuals in DuPage County have contracted the COVID-19 virus. New cases of COVID-19 are announced daily.

During the pendency of the Local State of Emergency, I shall execute such authority as Mayor as provided under the authority described above. This Declaration of Local State of Emergency shall be filed with the City Clerk as soon as practicable.

I, Steve Chirico, Mayor of the City of Naperville, being first duly sworn, have signed and executed this instrument as the Declaration of a Local State of Emergency and Disaster.
