The purpose of the project is to install a new traffic signal at the intersection of 95th Street and Knoch Knolls Road. 95th Street and Knoch Knolls Road is currently a four-way stop controlled intersection. The City has an agreement with Will County to allow the signal to be built when the intersection meets warrants, which it now does. Plans were prepared in 2015 and are ready for bid.
