ORDINANCE NO. 22-____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8 (PERSONNEL RESTRICTIONS FOR LIQUOR LICENSES), AND SECTION 12 (ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE RESTRICTIONS) OF TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL)

OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 8 (Personnel Restrictions for Liquor Licenses) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-8: PERSONNEL RESTRICTIONS FOR LIQUOR LICENSES:

4. BASSET Requirements: Every owner, manager, assistant manager, bartender, agent and employee who dispenses, sells, delivers or serves alcoholic liquor, as well as any employee or agent of a liquor license establishment that provides security services, including, but not limited to, bouncers, door staff, or floor personnel, shall provide evidence of successful completion of a Beverage Alcoholic Sellers and Servers Education Training (BASSET) program. Persons holding a special event or temporary permit are exempt from this requirement. For Class K, catering licenses, the training program requirement shall only apply to the licensee, its officers and mangers, at least one of whom has successfully completed the program, shall be at the location during the catered event. Such person(s) shall have supervisory authority over and be responsible for the actions of all employees not having the required training.

SECTION 2: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 12 (Additional Liquor License Restrictions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

Third-Party Promoters: Third-party promoters cannot be affiliated with or under the control of, either directly or indirectly, the liquor retailer, distributor or manufacturer, non-resident dealer, distributor, or importing distributor or foreign importer, in any manner. A third party promoter shall not give any financial remuneration directly or indirectly to a local liquor licensee. All retail liquor licensees utilizing the services of a third-party promoter shall file with the Local Liquor and Tobacco Commissioner, at least fourteen days in advance of an event or with a liquor license application, before any services are provided it by the third-party promotion company, an affidavit for approval from the owner of the third-party promotion company and an affidavit from the retailer including the following information but not limited to: an affidavit that provides the nature of sponsored the event and or services provided by the third-party promoter, details regarding the supplier of alcoholic liquor, a copy of Naperville BASSET certifications from any employee of the third-party promoter that will prepare, deliver or serve alcoholic beverages, and a letter of understanding, which states that each person affiliated with the third-party promoter has been advised of the rules and regulations regarding the preparation, sale, delivery and service of alcoholic liquor. ef the retailer, supplier and third party promoter. Third-party promoters are required to undergo fingerprinting and background checks and provide evidence of dram shop insurance insuring the licensee against liability which may occur under 235 ILCS 5/6-21, specifically designating the City as additional insured. Every third-party promoter shall be responsible for the acts and/or omissions to act by his or her employees, whether or not such third-party promoter has actual knowledge of unlawful acts or omissions.
