**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL),
SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

1. On-premises consumption liquor licenses:

Class A - Restaurant through
Class K – Catering

	Class M—Recreational or Lifestyle Amenities Facility
Requirements of Premises	Meets "Recreational or Lifestyle Amenities Facility" definition.
Container Requirements	For a recreational facility, liquor by drink, wine by bottle/carafe, beer by pitcher not to exceed 60 ounces or by drink not to exceed 16 ounces. For a lifestyle amenities facility, liquor by drink not to exceed 1.5 ounces, wine by drink not to exceed 6 ounces or beer by drink not to exceed 12 ounces, two drinks total per patron per visit to the premises.
Food Requirements	May be served as long as it complies with all health regulations and licensing requirements.
Liquor Service	For golf courses, liquor may be served outside the physical structure but must be adjacent to and within the property lines of golf course.
