**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 3 (DEFINITIONS) AND
SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 3 (Definitions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-3: - DEFINITIONS: For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR through
CRAFT BEER

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<u>CRAFT DISTILLED SPIRITS</u>	<u>Spirits from a craft distillery that manufactures alcoholic liquor in quantities not greater than one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons per calendar year or such quantities as may be permitted under the Illinois Liquor Control Act, as amended from time to time.</u>
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DOWNTOWN through
LEGITIMATE THEATER HOUSE

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<u>MANUFACTURER</u>	<u>Brewer, fermenter, distiller, rectifier, wine maker, blender, processor, bottler or person who fills or refills an original package, whether for himself or for another, and others engaged in brewing, fermenting, distilling, rectifying or bottling alcoholic liquors.</u>
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MINIATURE LIQUOR BOTTLE through
WINE OR VINOUS BEVERAGE

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SECTION 2: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

1. On-premises consumption liquor licenses:

Class A – Restaurant through Class O – Night Club * * *

	Class P – Brewery <u>Manufacturer</u>
Requirements of Premises	Retail sale of craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> only manufactured on premises. Portion of licensed premises for sale of craft beer, and wine, <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> (not more than 25% of total sq. ft.) shall be segregated from rest of premises.
Container Requirements	<u>Beer</u> By the glass, not more than 16 oz., by the bottle, not more than 12 oz., or by the flight, not more than 4 glasses with each glass not more than 4 oz. <u>Craft Distilled Spirits</u> by the glass, not more than 1.5 oz., or by the flight, not more than three glasses with each glass not more than .5 oz. <u>Wine</u> by the glass, not more than 6 oz., or by the flight, not more than three glasses with each glass not more than 2 oz.
Food Requirements	None.
Liquor Service	Consumption of craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> is limited to retail portion of premises, except during tours or private parties. No more than 3 servings to 1 customer per day.
Hourly Restrictions	Retail sale of craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> authorized during business hours.
Annual Fee	\$2,400.00
Other	Cap of 23 . <u>Manufacture of up to 3.7 million gallons 3,700,000 gallons craft beer and wine per year. Manufacture of up to 100,000 gallons craft distilled spirits per year.</u> <u>Records of manufacture must be maintained.</u> Marketing Event Permit available.

Class R – Legitimate Theater House through Class T – Heritage Society Cultural * * *

2. Off-Premises Consumption Liquor Licenses:

Class D – Package Store through

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	Class P – Brewery/Retailer <u>Manufacturer</u>
Requirements of Premises	Manufacturing portion must be separate from retail sale portion. Not more than 25% of the total retail sq. ft. are of the premises shall be designated to the retail sale of craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> .
Consumption	Off-premises, except consumption in the retail portion of premises, no more than 3 craft beers or wine per person/day. <u>Craft beer</u> by the glass not more than 16 oz., by the bottle not more than 12 oz., by flight of 4 glasses not more than 4 oz. <u>Craft Distilled Spirits by the glass, not more than 1.5 oz., or by the flight, not more than three glasses with each glass not more than .5 oz.</u> Wine by the glass, not more than 6 oz., or by the flight, not more than <u>three glasses with each glass not more than 2 oz.</u>
Container Requirements	Retail sale of craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits manufactured on</u> premises in its original package.
Liquor Tasting	Limited tastings during events.
Annual Fee	\$2,400.00
Other	Manufacture of up to 3,700,000 gallons craft beer and wine per year. <u>Manufacture of up to 100,000 gallons craft distilled spirits per year.</u> Must maintain records of total gallonage manufacture.

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	Marketing Event Permit
Requirements of Permit	Class P license holders only.
Consumption	On premises at event.

Container Restrictions	Craft beer and wine in containers no larger than 16 oz. <u>Craft distilled spirits in containers no larger than 1.5 oz. Wine in containers no larger than 6 oz.</u>
Food Service	None.
Type of Liquor Service	Craft beer, and wine <u>or craft distilled spirits</u> manufactured by the licensee and other brewers <u>manufacturers</u> .
Annual Fee	\$50: 1-1,999 attendees, \$100: 2,000-4,999, \$150: 5,000-9,999; \$200: 10,000+ plus City services.
Other	2/year. Sale to end by 9:30 p.m., consumption to end by 10:00 p.m.
