WHEREAS, Sikh Americans pursue diverse professions and make rich contributions to the social, cultural and economic vibrancy of the United States, including service as members of the United States Armed Forces and significant contributions to our great nation in agriculture, information technology, small businesses, trucking, medicine and technology; and,

WHEREAS, Sikh Americans distinguished themselves by fostering respect among all people through faith and service, and the City of Naperville seeks to further the diversity of its community by affording all residents the opportunity to better understand, recognize and appreciate the rich history and shared experiences of Sikh Americans.
