BOYS WATER POLO TEAM
2025 IHSA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP**

WHEREAS, Naperville North High School Boys' Water Polo Team has brought great pride and honor to the City of Naperville by capturing the 2025 Illinois High School Association (IHSA) State Championship; and

WHEREAS, this victory marks the first-ever boys' water polo state championship in the history of Naperville North High School; and

WHEREAS, the Huskies achieved a thrilling 7-6 come-from-behind victory over powerhouse New Trier in the championship game, demonstrating remarkable teamwork, resilience, and determination; and

WHEREAS, senior Jack Reif was named the Illinois Player of the Year, a testament to his outstanding skill, leadership, and performance throughout the season; and

WHEREAS, Mason Hofmann earned the title of Senior Scholastic Player of the Year, exemplifying the ideal balance of academic achievement and athletic excellence; and

WHEREAS, head Coach Kelly Reif was named the 2025 Illinois Boys' Water Polo Coach of the Year, becoming the first female coach in state history to earn this prestigious award and the first female coach to lead a boys' water polo team to a state championship in Illinois history; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Naperville North Huskies Boys' Water Polo Team has made history, inspired the community, and elevated the standards of high school athletics.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Wehrli, Mayor of the City of Naperville, do hereby proclaim May 24, 2025, as Naperville North High School Boys' Water Polo Champions Day in the City of Naperville, and urge all citizens to join in recognizing the remarkable accomplishments of these student-athletes, coaches, and the entire Naperville North High School community for this historic and inspiring achievement.
