

ORDINANCE NO. 21-_____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE
AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)
OF TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL)
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

1. On-premises consumption liquor licenses:

Class A – Restaurant through Class P – Manufacturer * * *

	Class R – Legitimate Theater House
Requirements of Premises	Meets “Legitimate Theater House” definition.
Container Requirements	Beer served by the glass or bottle only, not more than 12 oz., wine served by the glass only, not more than 6 oz.
Food Requirements	None.
Liquor Service	Service bar only.
Hourly Restrictions	Not more than one hour before the start of the <u>live theater</u> performance and no later than one-half hour before the end of a performance. <u>Service</u>

	<u>allowed during events (e.g. live music, birthday parties) that occur onsite at the legitimate theater house.</u>
Annual Fee	\$500.00
