**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A COMPLETE STREETS POLICY
IN THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE**

RECITALS

- A. The City of Naperville (City) routinely applies for and receives federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding for projects such as roadway resurfacing, roadway reconstruction, and other transportation-related capital improvement projects.
- B. The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) distributes these funds, and recently modified the project selection criteria to include regional performance measures in conformance with federal requirements.
- C. CMAP scores on their transportation impact, project readiness, and inclusion of planning factors.
- D. In the upcoming 2019 call for projects, one of the newly incorporated planning factors is that an agency must have an adopted Complete Streets policy in order to score points in that category.
- E. Complete Streets is the concept that roadways should be designed to safely and conveniently accommodate all users and all travel modes.
- F. The City's Complete Streets policy was developed using guidance and resource materials from CMAP, as well as research of how other communities are encompassing Complete Streets.
- G. Adopting a Complete Streets policy is in the best interest of the City and by adopting this policy, the City will now be formally applying Complete Streets practices as part of transportation projects.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, COUNTIES OF DUPAGE AND WILL, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule authority, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Recitals are a material part of this Resolution and are incorporated in this Section 1 as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: The Complete Streets Policy attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A is hereby adopted by the City of Naperville.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
