

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR THE CITY OF
NAPERVILLE, ILLINOIS-SPECIAL SERVICE AREA 33 (DOWNTOWN
MAINTENANCE EXPENSES AND MARKETING COSTS)**

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Naperville Special Service Area 33, formerly Special Service Area 26, (Downtown Maintenance Expenses and Marketing Costs) for 2020 will be held December 15, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, and pursuant to section 120/7(e) of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, the continuation of the Illinois Governor's disaster proclamation, and Naperville Mayor Chirico's executive order determining that in-person public meetings are not currently practical or prudent because of the COVID-19 pandemic, this public hearing will be held via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. All those interested are invited to attend the virtual public hearing via Zoom or over a telephone to contemporaneously hear all discussion, testimony and votes. Public comments may be submitted in writing in advance of the meeting and members of the public in attendance may sign-up in advance to provide live, oral comments.

- II. The property taxes extended for Service Area 33 for 2019 were \$1,056,694.88. The estimated property taxes to be levied for Service Area 33 for 2020 are \$1,146,702. This represents an 8.52% increase over the previous year.
