DISCUSSION:

On January 27, 2017, the City Manager awarded Contract 17-035 to Tremco Weatherproofing Technology Inc. (Tremco) to conduct roof inspections at 57 municipal facilities for the Department of Public Works - Public Buildings Operations (DPW-PBO). Tremco has completed the roof inspections and has provided DPW-PBO with reports that will allow staff to develop an aggressive maintenance plan to extend the life of roofs in acceptable condition or replace roofs nearing critical condition

Tremco has recommended the City restore rather than replace thirteen of the inspected roofs. Roof restoration extends the life of roofs up to 20 years and costs up to 80 percent less than a full roof replacement. However, before the restorations can be completed, an infrared analysis must be performed to ensure the existing insulation is dry. The not to exceed cost to perform this work at all thirteen locations is \$12, 350.

In addition, the metal room at Fire Station 7 has a leak. Despite multiple attempts to repair it, the leak continues to return. A water test is required to identify the source of the leak in order to complete a permanent repair and protect the building assets. Tremco has proposed to perform the water test for a cost not to exceed \$2,200.

This change order is requested in the amount of \$14,550 to complete the infrared analysis at the 13 facilities and the water test at Fire Station 7.

MB176 – Municipal Facilities Roof Replacement

This project includes inspections, assessments, evaluations and repairs of 106 roofs at 57 municipal buildings. The life expectancy of a roof is 20-25 years. Inspections allow the city to determine which facilities qualify for replacements or repairs.

Roof inspections and evaluations are budgeted to the capital improvement program and professional services accounts listed below. A total of \$397,000 is budgeted for inspections in CY2017. The requested change order is within budget.



Project Narrative:

The project will include the inspection and assessment of 106 roofs measuring 1,253,547 square feet at 57 buildings. The inspection will allow the City to develop an aggressive maintenance plan to extend the life of the roofs and replace only those roofs nearing critical condition. In CY2017, the City will replace the roof at the DuPage Children's Museum, Fire Stations 2 and at two Substations. The roof at the Municipal Center (36,200 square feet) was originally constructed in 1991. The life expectancy of a roof is 20-25 years. The roof replacement at the Municipal Center will be phased over three years. A five-year roof replacement plan for all city facilities will be developed in CY2017 for implementation in CY2018.

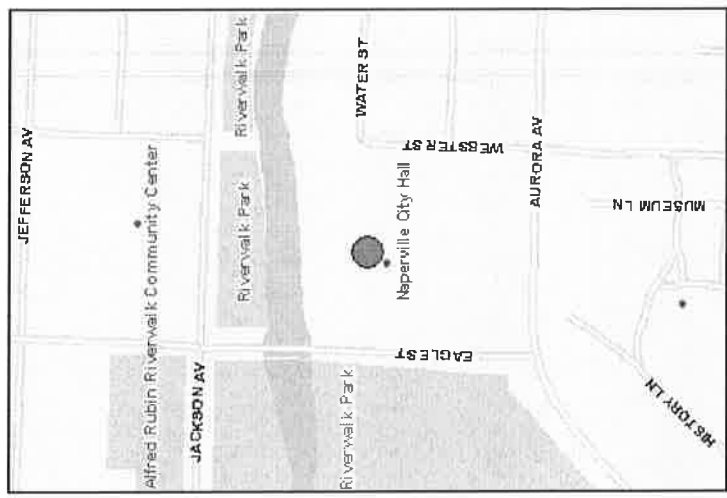

DESCRIPTION

The Department of Public Works-Public Buildings Operations (DPW-PBO) is responsible maintaining 106 roofs measuring 1,253,547 square feet at 57 different building locations. As approved in the 2017 Capital Improvement Program, MB176, Municipal Facilities Roof Replacement, includes the inspection and assessment each roof at all 57 locations. The inspections and reports will allow City staff to develop an aggressive maintenance plan to extend the life of roofs in acceptable condition or replace roofs nearing critical condition.

The DPW-PBO received a proposal from Tremco, Inc. to perform the inspection and condition rating services, and provide access to a roof top management program that will be used to track maintenance and budget planning. Tremco, Inc. is an approved contractor for National IPA, Contract #132205.

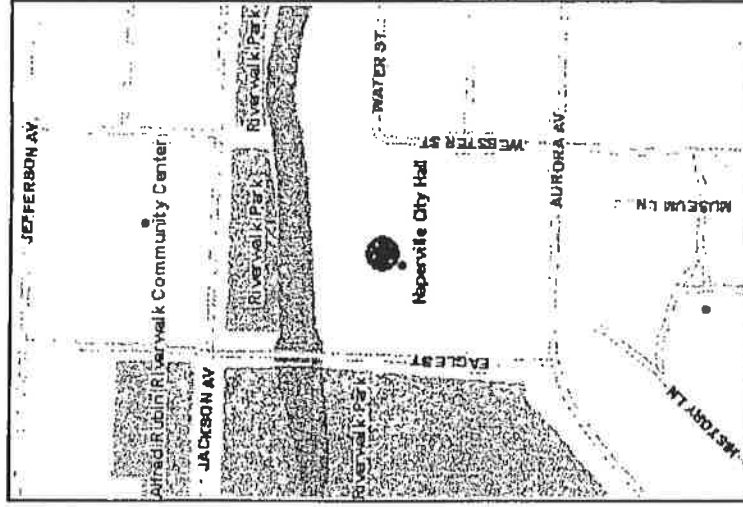
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
