WHEREAS, every year on the second Saturday in May, the National Association of Letter Carriers and the National Rural Letter Carriers Association mobilize to combat hunger during the Letter Carriers’ Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive; to date this nationwide one-day food drive has collected more than 1.5 billion pounds of food; and

WHEREAS, last year, Naperville letter carriers collected over 84,000 pounds of food donated for distribution by Loaves & Fishes Community Services to low-income families in our community. On this 25 year anniversary of the National Letter Carrier Food Drive, we hope to surpass that local collection.
