Re: Naperville Park District's Monthly Field Report for the Riverwalk

Commission Regular Meeting

Field Report for June, 2025:

 Staff focused on routine maintenance tasks including watering, weeding, pruning, and hedge-trimming

- 2 of the 3 picnic tables at the Free Speech pavilion were sanded and refinished, and over 70 benches have been pressure washed, sanded and stained (see pictures)
- Staff had to repair an irrigation valve that was located under the yews along Jackson Ave east of the Dandelion Fountain, which required removing some of the yews. New ones will be planted to fill in the gap.
- Earthworks planted perennial plugs in the shoreline restoration project area, which completed the installation of the project. A contractor will continue to assist with maintenance to get the new plants established and keep invasive weeds in check.
- The black-eyed Susans in the Prairie Nature Garden are putting on quite a show! (see picture)

• Carillon tours and recitals are scheduled through the summer.


Other points of interest:

The following are upcoming events the Park District is permitting to use the Riverwalk:

- LUSTGARTEN WALK (PANCREATIC CANCER RESEARCH) July 13 Grand Pavilion – 500 people expected
- FOUNDING FRIENDS PICNIC July 26 Grand Pavilion 100 people expected
- NAPERVILLE SPRINT TRIATHLON August 3 Uses Centennial Beach, City Streets and ends at the Grand Pavilion 2,000 people expected
- WESTERN SUBURBS LUPUS WALK August 9 Grand Pavilion 400 people expected
- INDIA DAY PARADE AND CELEBRATION August 10 Parade on Mill St from Naperville North to the Park District Administration building on Jackson – ROTARY HILL CELEBRATION CANCELLED FOR 2025 (Usually 8,000 people expected)
- NAPERVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY STORY STROLL August 16 Grand Pavilion 150 people expected
- LAST FLING August 29 through September 1 Jackson Ave from Ewing to Main St, Park District Administration Building parking lot, Alfred Rubin Riverwalk Community Center parking lot, Riverwalk parking lot at Main St, and Riverwalk Amphitheater (set up begins August 27) – up to 100,000 attendees expected (20,000 – 25,000 per day)
