

Project Description: On a radiant summer afternoon, the River Walk buzzes with life: laughter echoes as families stroll hand in hand, children running around and friends engage in lively conversations. The scene reminiscent of a Norman Rockwell painting, where every detail exudes warmth and camaraderie.

Naperville's essence lies in its deeply rooted values of wholesomeness and unity. Here, beneath the shade of autumn color trees, people from all walks of life come together, drawn by a shared appreciation for community and connection.

The painting, carefully crafted in a realistic style, invites passersby to pause and admire its beauty. Each vignette tells a story, capturing moments of joy, love, and togetherness that mirror the spirit of Naperville itself.

As the sun sets, casting a golden glow over the scene, the sense of belonging and harmony lingers in the hearts of all who have experienced its magic—a testament to the enduring values that make Naperville truly special.

Goals of the Project: to publicly depict, on a prominent outdoor wall plainly visible to all passersby, the full depth of the many races, creeds and colors of the residents of and visitors to Naperville

Scope/Dimensions of Project: one time installation of permanent wall mural, approximately 8'x16', on the south end of the east wall of 132 W. Jefferson, after artist has created the work on 5 panels off-site.
