ORDINANCE NO. 24 - _____

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY
LOCATED AT 720 PARKSIDE ROAD

RECITALS

1. **WHEREAS**, Jill Marlene Rudolph and Jeffrey Reid Rudolph, as Trustees under the Jill Marlene Rudolph Trust Agreement dated May 23, 2000, 828 Sanctuary Lane, Naperville, IL 60540, are the owners (referenced herein as "**Owner/Petitioner**") of real property located at 720 Parkside Road, Naperville, Illinois 60540, legally described on Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B ("**Subject Property**").
2. **WHEREAS**, the Owner/Petitioner has petitioned the City of Naperville ("City") for annexation of the Subject Property.
3. **WHEREAS**, the Subject Property is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, but is contiguous to the City of Naperville and eligible for annexation.

4. **WHEREAS**, all notices provided for by the Naperville Municipal Code, and all legal requirements for annexation pursuant to the provisions of 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/7-1-1 *et seq.*, have been fully complied with.
5. **WHEREAS**, the Owner/Petitioner has requested that the City approve this ordinance (“**Ordinance**”) along with ordinances approving an annexation agreement for the Subject Property, and rezoning of the Subject Property to R1B Medium Density Single-Family Residence District (hereinafter cumulatively referenced herein as the “**720 Parkside Road Ordinances**”).
6. **WHEREAS**, annexation of the Subject Property is contingent upon approval and recordation of an annexation agreement pertaining to the Subject Property.
7. **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Naperville has determined that annexation of the Subject Property should be approved as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Recitals are incorporated as though fully set forth in this Section 1. All exhibits referenced in this Ordinance shall be deemed incorporated and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: Subject to approval, execution, and recordation of an annexation agreement pertaining to the Subject Property, the Subject Property described on **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** is hereby annexed by the City of Naperville.

SECTION 3: The Plat of Annexation for 720 Parkside Road, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit B**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 4: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to record the 720 Parkside Road Ordinances, including their Exhibits, with the DuPage County Recorder in the following order: (1) an Ordinance approving an Annexation Agreement for the Subject Property; (2) an Ordinance approving Annexation of the Subject Property; and, (3) an Ordinance approving Rezoning of the Subject Property.

SECTION 5: Subsequent to recordation of an annexation agreement as referenced herein, the City Clerk is authorized and directed to record this Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed as depicted on the Plat of Annexation for 720 Parkside Road, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit B**, with the DuPage County Recorder and the DuPage County Clerk.

SECTION 6: If this Ordinance and the Annexation it approves are not recorded with the office of the Recorder in which the Subject Property is located within one (1) year of their approval and their passage by the Naperville City Council, this Ordinance and the Annexation shall be null and void without any further action by the City unless this Ordinance is amended by the City to extend such timeframe. The Petitioner/Owner shall defend, indemnify, and hold the City and its officers, agents and employees harmless if recordation does not occur within the original, or any extended, timeframe.

SECTION 7: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision, shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other City ordinance, resolution, or provision of the Naperville Municipal Code. Technical and minor substantive revisions as deemed acceptable to the City Attorney may be made

to this Ordinance and to the exhibits hereto prior to recordation with the office of the Recorder in which the Subject Property is located within.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after an annexation agreement for the Subject Property is executed and recorded.
