D. REPORTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

2. 19-333

Recommend approval to rescind stop control and establish a traffic-control signal intersection at 95th Street and Knoch Knolls Road.

Hynes explained that the new traffic signal at 95th Street and Knoch Knolls Road had recently been turned on. This item is being brought to TAB to clean up the Municipal Code so that it aligns with the current traffic control conditions.

Fischer thanked staff for their actions at this intersection to improve safety.

Overholt commented that speeds have increased on westbound 95th Street due to the signal. The Board briefly discussed why speeds would increase and Gustin asked if anything could be done by the City.

Williams stated that the Police Department will provide extra enforcement at that location.

A motion was made by Fischer, seconded by Overholt, to recommend approval to rescind stop control and establish a traffic-control signal intersection at 95th Street and Knoch Knolls Road.
