Commissioner Shields welcomed Dr. Maud Makoni, Natasha Araneta and Enya Wilkins with the North Central College Occupational Therapy Department. Dr. Makoni made a brief introduction noting it was the department's third time presenting to the Riverwalk Commission and thanked the group for the opportunity. Students Araneta and Wilkins reviewed the presentation that was included in the agenda packet. Items discussed included the distance between Riverwalk entrances, the possibility of adding visual distance markers, adding higher benches with more armrests, slope measurements on some of the ADA accessible ramps, and the width of the pathways on parts of the lower level.

Commissioner Hynes addressed concerns noting the sections of the Riverwalk that were built in the 1980's without ADA requirements and which are addressed to meet today's standards as we move forward with new projects. He also noted the restrictions when working in the floodways. In terms of slopes, the City spends an incredible amount of time making sure to meet requirements, and Commissioner Hynes noted the importance of using a survey grade level. Maintenance areas will be looked into and addressed and Commissioner Shields discussed the signs that are to be put in place to keep users from entering the lower levels during snow and flooding events. The students were invited to join the upcoming Asset Management Plan (AMP) Walks. Dr. Makoni will follow up with the Riverwalk Commission in the spring and fall to see if there are particular assignments for class collaboration.

The sled hill fence has been removed from Rotary Hill. The turf will be aerated, and seed and blanket will be added to any bare spots.

Several stone walls and wood bollard posts were pressure washed.

Staff put a fresh coat of paint on the planters and the hanging baskets for the covered bridges.

Staff began edging and mulching landscape beds and tree rings, starting with the Grand Pavilion area and working east.

Trees, shrubs, and perennials have been ordered and will be planted in April.
