WHEREAS, April is National Fair Housing Month, recognized by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the State of Illinois, celebrating passage of the 1968 Federal Fair Housing Act and the protections of the Illinois Human Rights Act to all people of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Nation and State recognize a fundamental need for all persons to have shelter and be free of illegal housing discrimination and practices that restrict one's efforts to attain housing; and

WHEREAS, by supporting and promoting fair housing and equal opportunity, we are contributing to the health of our communities; and,

WHEREAS, Fair Housing Month is an opportunity to provide residents with the knowledge and resources to obtain fair housing and to promote fair housing for all.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Steve Chirico, Mayor of the City of Naperville, do hereby proclaim April 2021 as
