Field Report for October, 2019:

- Staff is in the process of pulling out all of the annual flowers and planting the tulip bulbs for spring.
- Much of the turf has been aerated, fertilized and slit seeded.
- Staff has almost completed the process of closing down all the fountains, drinking fountains, and the irrigation system.
- Fall plantings are in the process of being completed.
- Annual flower designs for next year are being completed.

Other point of interest:

- Paddleboat and kayak rentals on the big quarry have closed for the season. All boats have been removed.
- The Riverwalk Café will be open during Healing Fields of Honor from 9am – 3pm November 1, 4-8 & 11 and from 9am – 5pm on November 2, 3, 9 & 10th.
