

Riverwalk AMP Walk Outline

April 29, 2026

Section 4:

- Start at Physicians and Dentists Overlook – erosion under concrete curbing and railing
- Chain link fencing around Paddleboat Quarry
- Aurora Ave retaining wall in City budget for 2028-2029
- Netzley Overlook – vision for the future
- Metal Bridge carvings – NPD staff to paint

Section 2:

- Paint peeling on bases of signs
- Pavers sinking along concrete curbing
- Shoreline Restoration Project (Jaycees playground and west to Sindt Woods)

Section 1:

- Retaining wall near Jefferson – fair condition, will monitor
- Pavers sinking along concrete curbing near Jefferson

Section 3:

- Stone fascia of planter at stairs between Beach and river
- Retaining wall and lower walkway west of covered bridge – bulging in spots
- Retaining wall and lower walkway east of covered bridge
- Admin parking lot repaving – moving an ADA spot closer to Eagle St Gateway

Section 4:

- Irrigation system and pump house
- Lower walk from shelter to Eagle St
- View of completed Eagle St Gateway project to end the walk

May 7, 2026

Section 5:

- Block wall on lower walk, east of Eagle St – will need a replacement plan for the future
- Outside picnic table at Free Speech – wood slats need to be replaced
- Covered Bridge Roof Replacement in City budget for 2027
- Japanese Tree Lilac condition around Dandelion Fountain

Section 6:

- Lower walk railing at stairways
- Lower walk stones missing and uneven
- [2031 Master Plan: Vision for Main to Washington if new development occurs – visualize pedestrian bridge concept](#)

Section 7:

- Ipe wood refresh – completed in 2025
- Fountain update
- Contractor to paint letters in granite stones
- Informational sign and items in windows of building – to be discussed at a future Commission meeting
- Viewing to and from 430 S Washington
- Railing along river – fair condition
- Zoo wall – NPD to attempt to pressure wash
- Lower area next to bridge and ramp – same prairie seed as 430 S Wash
