ORDINANCE NO. 26 - ____

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A VARIANCE
FROM SECTION 6-2-3:3.2 (YARD REQUIREMENTS) OF THE NAPERVILLE
MUNICIPAL CODE FOR
THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 501 LARKSPUR COURT**

RECITALS

1. **WHEREAS**, Vincent and Lisa Pappalardo (“**Petitioner**” and “**Owner**”), are the owners of real property located at 501 Larkspur Court, Naperville, Illinois, legally described on **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** (“**Subject Property**”), and have petitioned the City of Naperville for approval of a setback variance for said property.
2. **WHEREAS**, the Subject Property is currently zoned R1A (Low Density Single-Family Residence District) and is improved with a single-family residence.
3. **WHEREAS**, a deck currently exists on the Subject Property in the rear of the home, which currently encroaches into the required rear yard.

4. **WHEREAS**, the Owners and Petitioners plan to replace the existing deck attached to the rear of the home on the Subject Property, as depicted on **Exhibit C** (“**Site Plan**”).
5. **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Naperville Municipal Section 6-6A-7:1 (Yard Requirements), the Subject Property has a 28.65-foot rear yard setback in the R1A zoning district.
6. **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Naperville Municipal Section 6-2-3:3.2 (Yard Requirements), patios, decks and porches to extend up to ten (10) feet into the required rear yard setback, thus resulting in an 18.65-foot permitted setback for an attached deck from the rear property line at the Subject Property.
7. **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6-3-6:2 (Standards for Variances) of the Naperville Municipal Code, the Petitioner requests approval of a variance from Section 6-2-3:3.2 (Yard Requirements) of the Naperville Municipal Code to allow the proposed deck to encroach 12 feet 4 inches into the required rear yard for the Subject Property as depicted on the Site Plan.
8. **WHEREAS**, the requested variance meets the Standards for Variances as provided in **Exhibit D** attached hereto.
9. **WHEREAS**, on May 20, 2026, the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the requested variance and recommended approval of the Petitioner’s request.
10. **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Naperville has determined that the Petitioner’s request should be granted as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Recitals are incorporated as though fully set forth in this Section 1. All exhibits referenced in this Ordinance shall be deemed incorporated and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: A variance from Section 6-2-3:3.2 (Yard Requirements) of the Naperville Municipal Code to allow a deck to extend 12 feet 4 inches into the required rear yard for the Subject Property, as depicted on the Site Plan attached hereto as **Exhibit C**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: The Site Plan, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit C**, is hereby approved as the controlling site plan for the Subject Property.

SECTION 4: The variance approved by this Ordinance shall expire within two (2) years from the effective date of this Ordinance unless: (1) a building permit has been obtained and the construction or alteration of the structure as specified in this Ordinance has been started, or (2) the use specified in this Ordinance has commenced.

SECTION 5: This variance shall be subject to revocation for failure to comply with all other applicable provisions set forth in the Naperville Municipal Code, as amended from time to time, and all other applicable laws.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to record this Ordinance with the DuPage County Recorder.

SECTION 7: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision, shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other City ordinance, resolution, or provision of the Naperville Municipal Code. Technical and minor substantive revisions as deemed acceptable to the City Attorney

may be made to this Ordinance and to the exhibits hereto prior to recordation with the office of the Recorder in which the Subject Property is located within.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
