

ORDINANCE NO. 18-_____

AN ORDINANCE ENABLING THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, BY THE NAPERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO PATROL THE CARILLON CLUB OF NAPERVILLE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE RELATED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE CARILLON CLUB HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: The Naperville Police Department is hereby enabled to patrol and enforce the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code on the Carillon Club of Naperville Homeowners Association's private streets, pursuant to the Carillon Club of Naperville Homeowners Association's May 15, 2018 resolution requesting that the Naperville Police Department enforce the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code on its private streets and pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-209.1., which allows the City of Naperville to authorize the Naperville Police Department to enforce the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code on the Carillon Club of Naperville Homeowners Association's private streets pursuant to its request.

SECTION 2: The agreement between the City of Naperville and the Carillon Club of Naperville Homeowners Association allowing the Naperville Police Department to enforce the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code on private streets, attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the agreement between the City of Naperville and the Carillon Club of Naperville Homeowners Association allowing the Naperville Police Department to enforce the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code on private streets, attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
