Age Categories

This year, we are hosting two separate competitions based on age groups. Applicants aged 12-14 will compete in one showcase, while those aged 15-18 will compete in another. In each age group and each art medium, there will be a first, second, and third place winner.

Prizes

Grand prize winners in each age group and each art medium will receive a \$1,000 prize. Second place winners will receive a \$500 prize, and third place winners will be awarded a \$250 prize.

This year, we are reintroducing an in-person aspect to the competition. Winners will be required to send framed versions of their original artwork to the Sister Cities International National Office in Washington, DC, at their own expense. Further details will be shared with

winners in early summer 2025. The winning artwork will also be featured on the Sister Cities International website after the announcement.

All cash prizes for the 2025 winners **must be claimed within one month** of receiving notification of their win.
