### POINTS REGARDING POLO CLUB REFUSE PICK-UP

Based on review of City collection guidelines and a site visit to a recently built townhome community within Naperville, ample space is provided at Polo Club to facilitate orderly curbside refuse pick-up:

- The maximum number of units utilizing the same location for curbside pick-up is 21 units. There is a location in Mayfair with 20 units sharing a similar curbside area.
- Based on field observations made within Naperville (1/15/2019) the maximum number of refuse containers are not being placed out for pick-up each week.
- The City's garbage and recycling programs offer wheeled carts ranging from 35-95 gallons. It is likely that townhome residents will only require the smallest cart available.
- Garbage and recycling carts in townhome neighborhoods are being placed within driveway aprons with ample room for vehicular ingress/egress. No impact is expected to common open space areas.
- The City's collection guidelines state that empty containers must be removed from the curb by 7 p.m. on collection day, limiting the amount of time that garbage carts will be visible.
