Mayor Wehrli called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

**Petitioner Presentation: Temptinn Indian Fusion / Spinn by Temptinn**

Sujay Karvekar presented the application for Temptinn Indian Fusion and Spinn by Temptinn, located at 220-226 S. Washington. Spinn by Temptinn will occupy a 2,000-square-foot space within 226 S. Washington, designed as a lounge-style atmosphere for patrons aged 30 and older. The Petitioner clarified that the venue is not a dance club and will feature lounge seating, a large bar, and a staffed kitchen serving bar bites. The space will also host private events including birthday parties, corporate events, graduation parties, wedding parties. Petitioner noted that the space currently has occupancy for 65 people.

**Security and Operations**

Security protocols include ID screening at the Spinn entrance for general

admission. For private events, guests will enter through the main restaurant and be ID'd at the bar.

#### **Commission Discussion and Action**

Commissioner McGury inquired about the precedent for probationary periods for new licenses. Senior Assistant City Attorney Bonner confirmed that the City has previously issued licenses with such conditions, noting the duration is at the Commission's discretion.

The Commission reached a consensus to apply a six-month probationary period to the Class B Restaurant and Tavern license, the late-night permit, and the entertainment permit. Additionally, the Commission approved and referred a text amendment to the City Council to increase the late-night permit cap from 21 to 22, noting that any cap increase requires City Council approval.

#### **Petitioner Presentation: Club 59 Inc. dba Aura Club & Conventions**

Ajay Sunkara and Vinox Chanamolu presented the application for Club 59 Inc dba Aura Club & Conventions located at 808 S, Route 59 Suite 100. The business intends to continue the sale and service of alcoholic liquor in a manner consistent with the previous licensee's operations, requesting a Class B-Restaurant & Tavern license with Late Night permit and Entertainment permit and a Class K-Catering license.

#### **Security and Operations**

The event security and safety plan was presented by the petitioners.

#### **Commission Discussion and Action**

Commissioners questioned which areas of the establishment has liquor. There are 6 (six) bars within the establishment. 4 (four) in the ballroom, 1 (one) in the restaurant, and 1 (one) in the bar/concession area. The restaurant bar will be operated when the restaurant is open. The other 5 (five) bars will only operate when there is an event. Commissioners reinforced that the Class K-Catering license allows the sale and service of liquor only in connection with catering of foods and does not allow a cash bar.

The Commission approved the petitioners requests as follows:

Class B-Restaurant & Tavern license with Late Night Permit and Entertainment Permit for restaurant approved. Mover: Commissioner Douglas, Seconder: Commissioner Signorella

Class K-Catering license approved. Mover: Commissioner McGury, Seconder: Commissioner Digioia

### **BACKGROUND:**

Five Iron Golf Naperville is proposing a new second-floor concept at 47 E. Chicago Ave., featuring an indoor golf simulation venue paired with a full-service restaurant. The business is seeking a Late Night Permit that would allow the sale and service of alcoholic liquor until 1:00 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays. The company currently operates 42 additional locations across the United States.

Downtown Late Night Permits are currently limited to 22, available exclusively to Class B license holders, and all permits are already issued, leaving none available for new applicants.

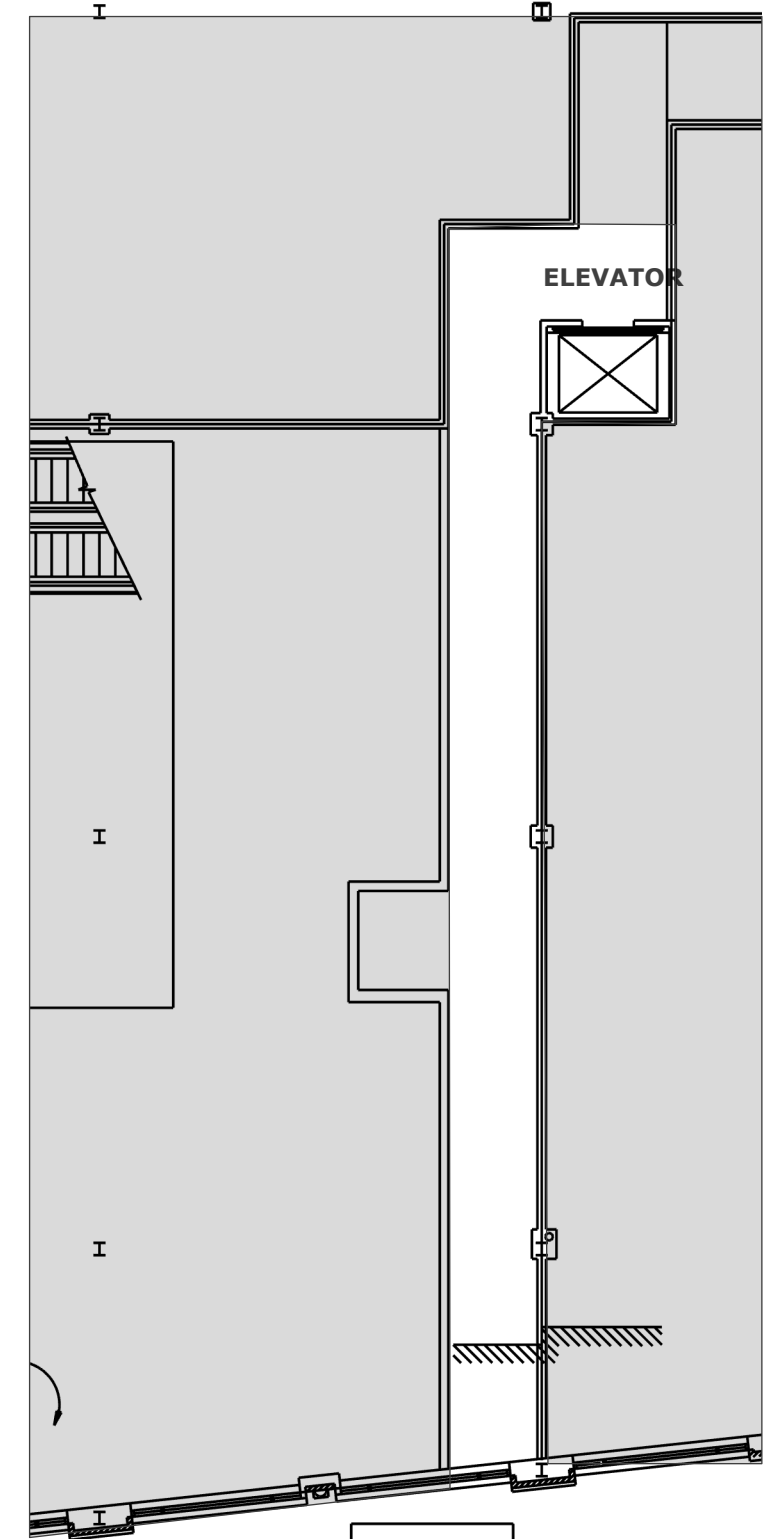
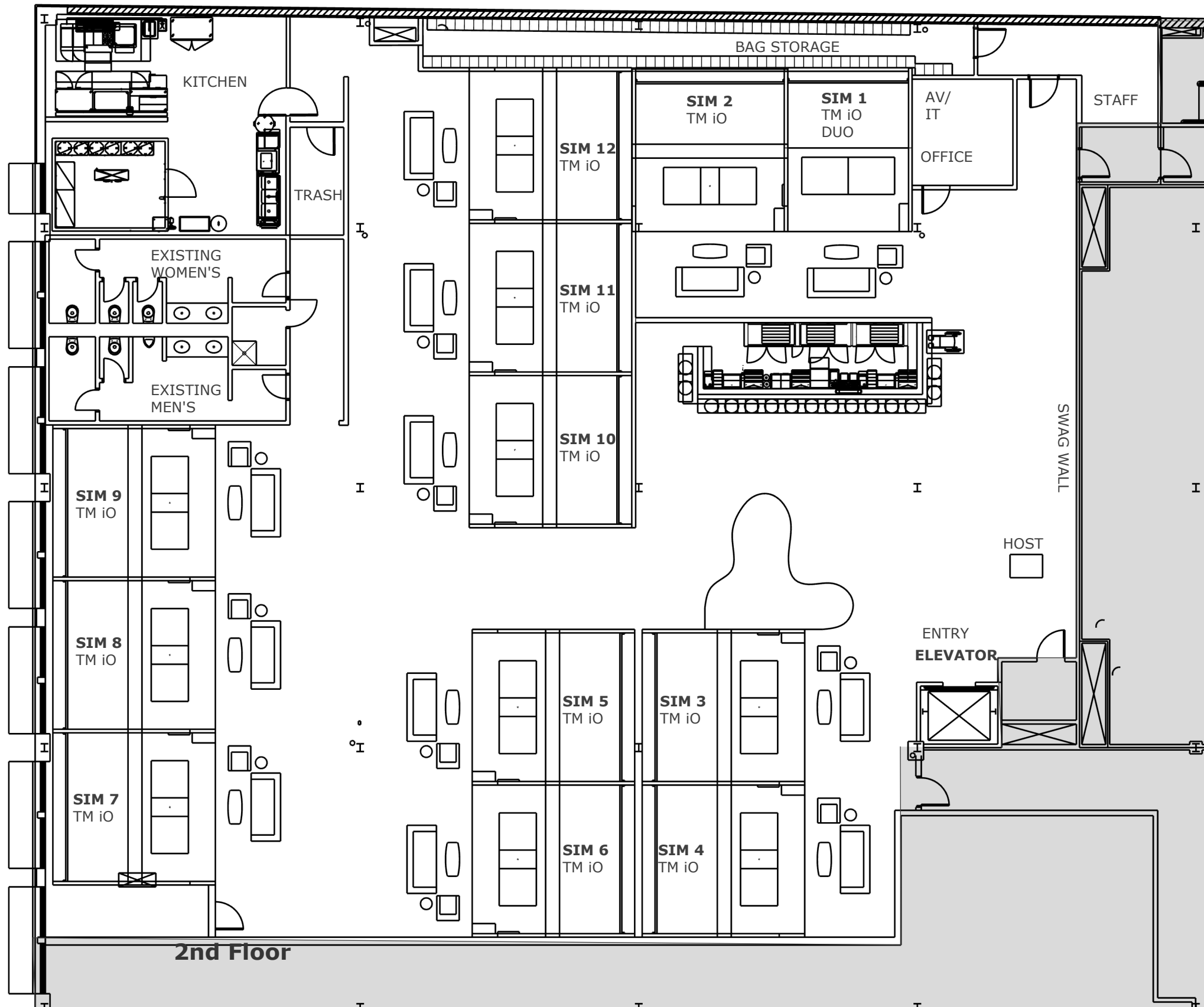

On September 3, 2019, the City Council adopted an ordinance restricting youth access to kratom. The measure bans the local retail sale of kratom to anyone under twenty-one and prohibits possession by individuals under eighteen, aligning local rules with the Illinois Kratom Control Act.

Kratom is derived from the leaves of a tropical evergreen tree native to Southeast Asia.

The leaves can be brewed as tea, crushed into powder, smoked, snorted, or taken in capsules or tablets. People have used kratom as a mood enhancer, energy booster, and pain reliever, and some advocates claim it may help with opioid withdrawal. However, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration warns against its use due to risks such as liver toxicity, seizures, and substance use disorder.

Several municipalities have responded to rising kratom use by adopting tighter controls. Rockford prohibits the sale of synthetic 7-OH kratom products, while Winnetka and Bloomington have implemented full retail sale bans. The City is now revisiting this issue to evaluate whether stricter local regulations may be warranted.
