Firework requirements are to meet the NFPA 1123 Code for Fireworks Display ... and the following:

- 1) Provide three signatures on the permit application; one must be the supervisor or lead operator of the display.
- 2) Provide a sufficient number of assistants for the safe conduct of the display and the safety of those watching the display.
- 3) Provide the names and birthdates of the operators and assistants.
- 4) Provide the years of experience for the operator and assistants.
- 5) The security of the site is the responsibility of the fireworks company and the event sponsor.
- 6) Provide a scaled site map. Show distance from firing site to spectators, parking, residences, commercial buildings, and show fallout radius.
- 7) Provide an insurance declarations page.
- 8) Provide a copy of the company's ATF license.
- Provide a list/inventory of shells and the size of the largest shell (inside diameter)
- 10) Provide letters authorizing to use the property for fallout and launch site.
- 11) Provide a sufficient number of fire extinguishers charged and tagged.
- 12) The sponsor of the display shall make provisions for adequate protection for the display.
- 13) Monitors, whose sole duty shall be the enforcement of crowd control, shall be located around the display area and at other locations as determined by the sponsor.
- 14) Monitors shall be positioned around the discharge site to prevent spectators or any other unauthorized persons from entering the discharge site. The discharge site shall be so restricted throughout the display and until the discharge site has been inspected after the display.
- 15) During the firing of the display, all personnel within the discharge site shall wear head protection, eye protection, hearing protection, and foot protection; and shall wear cotton, wool, or similarly flame-resistant, long-sleeved, long-legged clothing. Personal protection equipment as necessary shall be worn by the operator and assistants during the setup and cleanup of the display.



Operation of the Display.

- 1. The operator shall provide fire protection at the site as required by the fire chief or his/her designee.
- 2. Only permitted fireworks are authorized for use.
- 3. Fireworks display shall be 100% electrically fired.
- 4. If, in the opinion of the fire chief or his/her authorized representative, lack of crowd control should pose a danger, the display shall be immediately discontinued until such time as the situation is corrected.
- 5. If at any time high winds or unusually wet weather prevail such that, in the opinion of the fire chief, his/her authorized representative or the display operator, a definite danger exists, the public display shall be postponed until weather conditions improve to permit safe discharge of fireworks.
- 6. Light snow or mist need not cause cancellation of the display; however, all materials used in the display shall be protected from the weather until immediately prior to use.
- 7. Display operators and assistants shall use only flashlights or approved electric lighting for artificial illumination.
- 8. No smoking or open flames shall be allowed within 50 feet of the firing or storage area as long as shells are present. Signs to this effect shall be conspicuously posted.
- 9. The first shell fired shall be carefully observed to determine that its trajectory will carry it into the intended firing range and that the shell functions over, and any debris falls into, the planned landing area.
- 10. The mortars shall be re-angled or reset if necessary at any time during the display.
- 11. When a shell fails to ignite in the mortar, the mortar shall not be touched for a minimum of five minutes. After five minutes it shall be carefully flooded with water. Immediately following the display, the mortar shall be emptied into a bucket of water. The supplier shall be contacted as soon as possible for proper disposal instructions.
- 12. Operators shall not attempt to repair a damaged shell nor shall they attempt to dismantle a dry shell. In all such cases, the supplier shall be contacted as soon as possible for proper disposal instructions.
- 13. Operators shall not dry a wet shell, lance, or pot for reuse.
- 14. The vendor and the sponsor shall provide perimeter control that will keep pedestrians out of the fallout zone. The entire firing range shall be inspected 15min following the display to locate any defective shells. Any such shells found shall be immediately doused with water before handling. The shells shall be placed in a bucket of water. The supplier shall then be contacted as soon as possible for proper disposal instructions.
- 15. When fireworks are displayed in darkness the sponsor shall ensure that the firing range is inspected early the following morning.
- 16. Any fireworks remaining unfired after the display shall be immediately disposed of or removed from the city/village and returned to the supplier from which they were purchased or to a location approved by the police chief or his/her designee.
- 17. The debris from discharged fireworks shall be properly disposed of.
