AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS) AND SECTION 12 (ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE RESTRICTIONS) OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and

Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville

Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:
