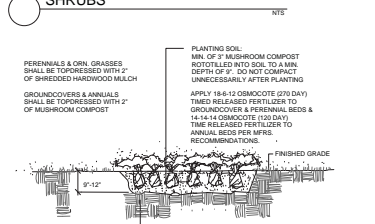
DECIDUOUS TREE



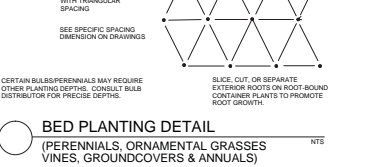
EVERGREEN TREE

STORMWATER SEED MIX

Carbio-F-Pave - Apply @ 32.8 PLS pounds per acre

Table listing botanical and common names for the Stormwater Seed Mix, including species like Carex cristatella, Carex lunata, and Carex vaginosa.

Table listing botanical and common names for the Wet-to-Mesic Prairie Seed Mix, including species like Aster nothoanglicus, Baptisia lactuca, and Chamaecrista fasciculata.

WETLAND EDGE SEED MIX

Table listing botanical and common names for the Wetland Edge Seed Mix, including species like Carex canova, Carex cristatella, and Carex flaccida.

ECONOMY PRAIRIE SEED MIX

Carbio-F-Pave - Apply at 37.2 PLS pounds per acre

Table listing botanical and common names for the Economy Prairie Seed Mix, including species like Andropogon gerardi, Boutelou curtipendula, and Carex cap.

NO MOW FESCUE SEED MIX

Prarie Nursery, Westfield, MI

Table listing common names and percentages for the No Mow Fescue Seed Mix, including SRP100 Cheviang Fescue and Sheep Fescue.

NATIVE AREA MAINTENANCE

The installing Contractor shall provide a three (3) year maintenance program as part of the installation contract for all native prairie and native pond bottom areas...

TEMPORARY COVER:

Table listing quantities for temporary cover materials, such as Avena sativa (Seed Oats) and Lolium multiflorum (Annual Ryegrass).

FORBS:

Table listing quantities for forb seeds, including Aster nothoanglicus, Baptisia lactuca, and Chamaecrista fasciculata.

Selective herbicide treatment of certain aggressive perennial weeds may be necessary during the 2nd & 3rd growing seasons if mowing and burning fail to control them.

Maintenance Schedule: 1st Growing Season: Mow up to three times (3x) to keep annual weeds from going to seed and to avoid too much shade...

2nd Growing Season: Mow in Spring to the ground and remove cuttings. Repeat in full bloom in late spring or early summer if weeds remain a problem.

3rd Growing Season: Burn between October 15 and May 1, with a mid Spring burning being preferred, and continue other weed management practices as needed during the 3rd growing season.

NATIVE AREA MAINTENANCE

NATIVE PRAIRIES, NATIVE POND SHORELINES & BANKS

The Contractor shall be responsible for the satisfactory growth of permanent species of grasses, forbs, reeds and sedges on all areas seeded or planted under the contract until final acceptance of the work.

None of the three (3) most dominant species may be native or woody species, including but not limited to, Canary Reed Grass, Common Reed, Sweet, Canadian Thistle, Horse-nettle, Spotted Knawweed, Purple Loosestrife, Sandbar Willow, Teasel, Cow or Cattails, unless otherwise indicated on the approved planting plan.

LONG TERM MAINTENANCE (OWNER)

The Contractor shall provide a copy of the Long-Term Operation and Maintenance Plan to the Owner, Facilities Manager or Home Owners Association for continued maintenance of the native planting areas.
