We recommend that the challenge/appeal process be conducted for 60 minutes immediately following the administration and scoring of the test. IOS will manage the appeal process.

Do you select and train the rating panel(s)?	Yes, IOS will recruit and train assessors. An assessment center for 60 candidates will likely require 6 to 9 assessors for a period of five days (assuming 3 exercises are used).

IOS will develop a tailored assessment center containing 3 distinct assessment exercises based on meeting with local subject matter experts, recruit and train assessors, supply role-players (as needed), administer the assessment center, produce a rank-ordered list of scores, and generate candidate feedback reports.

Do you conduct an orientation for candidates?	Yes, optional
What does the orientation include?	Presentation of promotion process components, comprehensive information book including administration and scoring details, tips on how to prepare, sample test items, allow questions from candidates. Depending on room setup and equipment options, the orientation session may include PowerPoint.
Cost	\$1,000 per day (1 or 2 sessions offered each day); can schedule multiple days
WRITTEN TEST	\$5,500.00
Do you score on-site? (If not done on site - how soon will scores be received?)	Yes, optional
Cost	If not scored on-site, scores shall be released within one week after administration or earlier.
How many administrators for 60 candidates?	Two test administrators for 60 candidates, one of whom will score the tests afterward if on-site scoring is requested.
Cost	\$500 per administrator
What is the cost of the test?	\$3,500 for up to 40 candidates; \$25 for each candidate over 40 (20 more candidates x \$25 each = \$500)
Cost	Total written exam = \$4,000 + 1,000 if on-site scoring is selected + 500 if a total of 60 candidates

Do you select and train the rating panel(s)?	Yes, follow department and Illinois state statute regarding certified assessors
Cost	\$0 for securing raters and \$500 for training
What is the cost for the assessment center?	\$3,000 for first 20 candidates; \$35 per candidate over 20 (40 additional candidates x \$35 = \$1,400. There were only 44 candidates in 2017)

How many administrators for 60 candidates?	Two administrators per day @ \$500 each (3 days estimated based on 2017)
Cost	\$3,000
	Total assessment = \$500 training + \$3000 for 20 candidates + \$1,400 if additional 40 candidates + \$3,000 for two monitors/three days
