

ORDINANCE NO. 25-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL),
SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

1. On-premises consumption liquor licenses:

Class A - Restaurant through
Class K – Catering

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	Class M—Recreational or Lifestyle Amenities Facility
Requirements of Premises	Meets "Recreational or Lifestyle Amenities Facility" definition.
Container Requirements	For a recreational facility, liquor by drink, wine by bottle/carafe, beer by pitcher not to exceed 60 <u>ounces</u> , or by bottle <u>drink</u> not to exceed 16 <u>ounces</u> . For a lifestyle amenities facility, <u>liquor by drink not to exceed 1.5 ounces</u> , wine by the drink not to exceed 6 <u>ounces</u> , or beer by the drink not to exceed 12 <u>ounces</u> , two drinks total per patron <u>per visit to the premises</u> .
Food Requirements	May be served as long as it complies with all health regulations and licensing requirements.
Liquor Service	For golf courses, liquor may be served outside the physical structure but must be adjacent to and within the property lines of golf course.

Hourly Restrictions	<u>For a recreational facility, Ssale and service of alcoholic liquor shall be limited to only during</u> the time that the recreational portion of the premises is open and available for use, <u>or with</u> <u>For a recreational facility, sale and service of alcoholic liquor may occur until 7:00 p.m. and shall be limited to patrons purchasing a paid lifestyle amenities service.</u>
Annual Fee	Recreational Facility: \$2,200.00 Lifestyle Amenities Facility: \$500.00
Other	Recreational Facility: Cap of 12. Lifestyle Amenities Facility: Cap of 5. Certified record of annual revenue may be requested by the Liquor Commissioner. Insurance required for outside premises.
