ORDINANCE NO. 25-	
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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS) OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

1. On-Premises Consumption Liquor Licenses: * * *

2. Off-Premises Consumption Liquor Licenses:

Class D – Package Store through Class G1 – Grocery Store

	Class G2 – Boutique Market
Requirements of Premises	Grocery store of at least 45,000 square feet. No more than 8% of its total merchandise display space shall be for alcoholic beverages. The sales of groceries shall account for 80% of gross store sales. On-premises sales of beer, and wine dispensed for immediate consumption via an electronic, automated wine dispensing and preservation system designed to keep opened bottles of wine fresh and ready to use over time ("cruvinet wine") shall be limited to a separate point of sale (i.e., cash register) at a service counter.
Consumption	Off premises, except for consumption of beer and cruvinet wine is permitted while shopping throughout the entire retail floor area of the premises if beer or cruvinet wine is served from one of the two indoor service areas between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 8:00p.m., Monday through Friday, and 8:00a.m. and 7:00p.m., Saturday and Sunday. Alcoholic liquor sold in original packages and intended for off-premises consumption shall not be opened or consumed on the premises.

Container	Wine in the original package shall not be sold in containers less than 325				
Requirements	milliliters. Each serving of cruvinet wine shall not exceed 5 ounces.				
Liquor	3 tastings per person/day; no more than ¼ ounce of spirits, 1 ounce of				
Tasting	wine, or 2 ounces of beer per tasting.				
Annual Fee	<u>\$5,000.00</u>				
Other	Requires submittal of drawing showing actual floor area of the premises which designates the separate point of sales for on-premises consumption of beer and cruvinet wine along with service areas. Designated floor area shall be attended and supervised by a BASSET certified employee. Sales and consumption shall be monitored by live video and recording devices. Footage from the video and recording devices must be retained for ninety (90) days and provided upon request to an authorized law enforcement agent. Cap of 1.
