Hipped roof with carved wood brackets (some with dropped pendants) under eaves; paneled wood frieze; 3-sided 2-story south window bay; front entry with double wood paneled doors, segmental arch transom, and incised wood surround; historic 2/2 and 1/1 wood windows with elaborate incised wood hoods and center wood keystones; south side entry with double wood door; porch with elaborate round arch wood openings
