ORDINANCE NO. 26 - ____

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A VARIANCE
FROM SECTION 6-6C-7:1 (YARD REQUIREMENTS) OF THE NAPERVILLE
MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT AN ATTACHED GARAGE LOCATED AT
693 COTTAGE AVENUE**

RECITALS

1. **WHEREAS**, Douglas May, 693 Cottage Avenue, Naperville, IL 60540 (“**Petitioner**” and “**Owner**”), is the owner of real property located at 693 Cottage Avenue, Naperville, Illinois, legally described on **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** (“**Subject Property**”), and has petitioned the City of Naperville for approval of a variance to the rear setback limitation for an attached garage at the Subject Property.
2. **WHEREAS**, the Subject Property is currently zoned R2 (Single-Family and Low Density Multiple-Family Residence District) and is improved with a two-story single-family residence.

3. **WHEREAS**, the Subject Property does not currently have a garage located on the lot and the Petitioner has been utilizing an existing detached garage located at 695 N Fremont Street.
4. **WHEREAS**, the Owner and Petitioner proposes to demolish the detached garage located at 695 N Fremont Street and construct an attached garage to the existing single-family home at the Subject Property.
5. **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 6-6C-7:1 (Yard Requirements) of the Naperville Municipal Code, the required rear yard setback is twenty-five (25) feet in the R2 District.
6. **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6-3-6:2 (Standards for Variances) of the Naperville Municipal Code, the Petitioner requests approval of a variance from Section 6-6C-7:1 (Yard Requirements) of the Naperville Municipal Code to allow a one-story attached garage with a footprint of approximately 650 square feet to be constructed five (5) feet into the required rear yard on the Subject Property as depicted on **Exhibit C** (“**Site Plan**”).
7. **WHEREAS**, the requested variance meets the Standards for Variances as provided in **Exhibit D** (“**Response to Standards**”) attached hereto.
8. **WHEREAS**, on February 4, 2026, the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the requested rear setback variance and recommended approval of the Petitioner’s request.
9. **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Naperville has determined that the Petitioner’s request should be granted as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Recitals are incorporated as though fully set forth in this Section 1. All exhibits referenced in this Ordinance shall be deemed incorporated and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: A variance from Section 6-6C-7:1 (Yard Requirements) of the Naperville Municipal Code to allow a one-story attached garage with a footprint of approximately 650 square feet to be constructed five (5) feet into the required rear yard on the Subject Property, as depicted on the Site Plan attached hereto as **Exhibit C**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: The Site Plan, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit C**, is hereby approved as the controlling site plan for the Subject Property.

SECTION 4: The variance approved by this Ordinance shall expire two (2) years from the effective date of this Ordinance unless: (1) a building permit has been obtained and the construction or alteration of the structure as specified in this Ordinance has been started, or (2) the use specified in this Ordinance has commenced.

SECTION 5: This variance shall be subject to revocation for failure to comply with all other applicable provisions set forth in the Naperville Municipal Code, as amended from time to time, and all other applicable laws.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to record this Ordinance with the DuPage County Recorder.

SECTION 7: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision, shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this

Ordinance or any other City ordinance, resolution, or provision of the Naperville Municipal Code. Technical and minor substantive revisions as deemed acceptable to the City Attorney may be made to this Ordinance and to the exhibits hereto prior to recordation with the office of the Recorder in which the Subject Property is located within.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
