DESCRIPTION

The Department of Public Works - Public Buildings Operations (DPW-PBO) Division and the Water Utilities require the services of a licensed heating, ventilation, air conditioning and dehumidification (HVAC-D) contractor to perform services on an as-needed basis for HVAC-D work either beyond the scope of the in-house staff and/or to augment and improve the efforts of in-house staff.

The City Manager approved the award of Contract 17-077 on May 10, 2017 to Beery Heating and Cooling and Hayes Mechanical LLC. The licensed HVAC-D contractors provide services consisting of maintenance, repair and replacement of the HVAC and dehumidification systems and associated equipment located at more than 50 city facilities maintained by DPW-PBO and seven secured facilities maintained by the Water Utilities.

Beery Heating and Cooling and Hayes Mechanical LLC have performed well during the original contract term. Staff was able to negotiate a zero-percent increase for the first option year with both contractors. The contract includes all labor, tools, materials, and equipment required to complete the related services. The term of the contract extension is May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019, with two one-year option years remaining.

FISCAL IMPACT

Heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and dehumidification services are expensed to the building and grounds maintenance accounts below. A total of \$412,000 has been budgeted for building maintenance, which includes HVAC service, in CY2018. The requested award of \$93,204.10 is within the budgeted amount for this expense.



DESCRIPTION

The Department of Public Works-Public Buildings Operations (DPW-PBO) retains the services of a licensed heating, ventilation, air conditioning and dehumidification (HVAC-D) contractor to perform services on an as-needed basis for related work either beyond the scope of the in-house staff and/or to augment and improve the efforts of the DPW-PBO work. The City Manager approved the award on February 24, 2017 for a one year term from March 1, 2017 through February 28, 2018, with three, one-year options to extend.

The Police Department, located at 1380 Aurora Avenue, currently needs an electric duct furnace installed in the lower air handling unit to maintain a consistent temperature in the detention area, evidence lab and adjacent offices. Per code, the required air turnover must be comprised of 100% outside air. Under the current system configuration, the areas experience extreme cooling and heating that is manually corrected. The installation of this unit seeks to correct the temperature differential. Beery Heating and Cooling submitted an estimate of \$19,810 to provide the needed air handling unit and complete installation based on specifications provided by DPW-PBO. This change order is requested for the installation of an electric duct furnace in the lower level air handling unit. This work at the Police Department was not planned; thus, it was not budgeted in the original award.





DESCRIPTION

The Department of Public Works – Public Buildings Operations (DPW-PBO) Division and the Water Utilities require the services of a licensed heating, ventilation, air conditioning and dehumidification (HVAC-D) contractor to perform services on an as-needed basis for HVAC-D work either beyond the scope of the in-house staff and/or to augment and improve the efforts of in-house staff. Previously, DPW-PBO and Water conducted separate procurements for these services. For the first time in 20 years, these services are being bid together.

Award will be recommended to the vendor(s) with the lowest base bids for City facilities and Water facilities separately. The licensed HVAC-D contractor(s) must be able to provide services consisting of maintenance, repair and replacement of the HVAC and dehumidification systems and associated equipment located at more than 50 city facilities maintained by DPW-PBO and seven secured facilities maintained by the Water Utilities. The contractor(s) will be required to furnish all labor, tools, materials and equipment required to complete related services and ensure project completion. This service agreement will include responding to routine as well as emergency calls.




