<b>Q:</b>	<b>What is the new weight limit? What was the old limit? Is this section of road a truck route?</b>	<b>Hinterlong</b>
<b>A:</b>	There is no new weight limit for the bridge. We only post weight limits for those structures that can no longer carry the standard HS-20 design loads, which the new bridge can carry. The old weight limit was 25 tons based on the analysis performed with the deteriorated sections of the old structure considered.  This section of 5 <sup>th</sup> Avenue is not a designated truck route.	Novack
