<b>I.3</b>	<b>Approve the award of Option Year Two to Contract 22-058.2, Storm Sewer Lining, to Hoerr Construction for an amount not to exceed \$650,000, and a 3% contingency</b>	
<b>Q.</b>	1. 250K represents what percentage of the total linear feet of the city's storm sewers? 2. How many feet are in the 3 subdivisions planned in 2024?	<b>Longenbaugh</b>
<b>A.</b>	1. The 250,000 feet of pipe that has been lined is .4% of the total feet of the City's storm sewers. Much of the storm system is in good condition and will not need to be lined for many years. 2. Due to the size of the pipes in these areas, approximately 9,400 linear feet are planned to be lined in 2024.	<b>Dublinski</b>

<b>I.9</b>	<b>Waive the applicable provision of the Naperville Procurement Code and award Procurement 24-096, Hot Mix Asphalt, to Arrow Road Construction, Builders Asphalt, Chicago Materials Corporation, PT Ferro Asphalt, RW Dunteman, and Superior Asphalt Materials for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 and for a one-year term (requires six positive votes)</b>	
<b>Q.</b>	1. Does this contract include both hot and warm mix asphalt (WMA)? In March 2022, Council amended this contract to include both hot and warm mix. (Council did not amend it in March 2023.) 2. Is there recent information from IDOT that we should be considering about WMA?	<b>Longenbaugh</b>
<b>A.</b>	1. This contract will include both hot and warm mix asphalt. If warm mix asphalt is available DPW will use that. If it is not available then hot mix asphalt will be used. 2. The Illinois Department of Transportation has been very quiet about warm mix asphalt over the last year.
