Commission Regular Meeting

Field Report for March, 2018:

Many of the landscape beds have received an application of pre-emergent herbicide.

- Picnic tables at the Grand Pavilion are being "refreshed" for the season.
- Staff has completed the process of cutting back grasses and perennials.
- Bulbs have pushed through the soil but are not showing color, yet.
- Steve Piper & Sons has completed the four days of Overstory Tree Pruning hitting the south shoreline of the river starting at the Café, heading west. Numerous invasive plants were removed along with some dead trees that had fallen into the river.
- A small volunteer group of three has started working in the Sindt Woods, removing invasives. This group will be working two to three hours every other week throughout the fall season.
- Sled hill fences have been taken down and seed and blanket will be added shortly.

• The Millennium Carillon weekly concert series is scheduled to begin on April 7th.

Other points of interest:

- The pumping at Centennial Beach has been completed and should stay empty until April 16th.
