KYLE ZULEG FOUNDATION DAY

APRIL 17, 2018

WHEREAS, over 4,600 individuals in the state of Illinois are in need of a life-saving organ transplant; and

WHEREAS, April is National Donate Life Month, a month dedicated to help encourage people to register as eye, tissue and organ donors and to celebrate and remember those that have saved lives through the gift of donation; and

WHEREAS, the Kyle Zuleg Foundation provides monogrammed "Forever in our Heart" blankets to organ donor families in all Gift of Hope affiliated hospitals in Illinois and Northwest Indiana with the hope that it provides warmth, comfort and support; and

WHEREAS, the Kyle Zuleg Foundation is celebrating 7 years of being an approved 501 (c) 3 not-for profit organization that has provided hundreds of blankets to families and has given more than \$43,000 in scholarship money to students in the Naperville 203 and 204 school districts; and

WHEREAS 16 year-old Kyle Zuleg became a HERO to 5 people on October 19, 2010 after a tragic accident.
